ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS FOR 3D PRINTING

Update to the Safety & Health guide on 3D Printing

The Safety & Health guide on 3D Printing is now updated to include the hazard of cut by sharp object, arising from removing a 3D printed product from the printing platform.

Users of 3D printing are strongly recommended to review and update their risk assessments to include this hazard if applicable and to adopt the mitigation measures from a higher control if possible.
